

THE CITY-BAY RUN - We know that a large contingent from Tea Tree Gully took part in the City-Bay Run last Sunday, although a few results are known we have not yet compiled a full list, perhaps next week.

Congratulations to all who represented us, little athletes, seniors and parents alike. How many shared the sentiments expressed to me by one such runner, "The worst part was seeing some runners who had already completed the course running back to Adélaide to collect their cars while I still had quite a distance to go."

SAFETY

In Athletics, there exists a responsibility both for awareness of the need for safety precautions and for their observance at all times.

Safe methods must be taught from the beginning. As the Athlete progresses through the various activities they must be made fully aware of the potential dangers involved, and the necessary safety precautions to be observed.

Spectators must also be aware of the safety aspects and should co-operate by watching from behind safety equipment or where no safety device provided, from a safe distance.

At training sessions many athletes may be experimenting with developing new techniques of throwing various implements with little safety equipment, so it is vital to be aware of the situation.

THROWING EVENTS

- 1. Throwing implements must be treated at all times with respect.
- 2. All throwers should stand behind the throwing circle until called up for their throw.
- 3. Only one athlete should throw at a time. The athlete and the coach/official must ensure the throwing area is free before commencing the throw.
- 4. The Discus/Shot MUST NOT be thrown back to the circle, it should be carried.
- 5. Discus officials should not stand on the right hand side of a right handed thrower (converse).
- 6. Athletes must not "play about" with the Shot. It may drop onto an Athletes foot causing permanent damage.

Rules and regulations for both Senior and Little Athletics competition are included and they likewise will not be reprinted.


The Social calendar is a brief outline of the planned events for the season, further information will be given from time to time but we hope you will all consider supporting our functions and keep the dates free.



RICHARD DAVIS, (SUB-JUNIOR) AT MT. CRAWFORD.




START OF SENIOR RACE AT MT. CRAWFORD 6.9.80.
